SCOTTISH INTER-LEAGUE COMPETITION - RULES & FORMAT 2022

The Inter-League Competition is a team event featuring male and female teams in Senior, Veteran, Junior, Cadet and Minor categories selected by and representing affiliated member Leagues and Associations of Table Tennis Scotland.

Rules:

Eligibility: Players eligible to play in the Inter-League Competition must be registered members of the League or Association that they will represent and must be registered with Table Tennis Scotland by 31st December of the year preceding the relevant Inter-League competition. Players must also have played in at least four (4) league matches in the League or Association they are representing before the date of the relevant Inter-league Competition.

Cadets and Minors who do not play in the main league must either play in a Junior League affiliated to TTS or be part of a recognised coaching programme. In both cases players must be affiliated to Table Tennis Scotland.

Age Categories:

Senior: no age restriction

Veterans over 40 by 31/12/2021

Junior: players born after 31/12/2003

Cadet: players born after 31/12/2007

Minor: players born after 31/12/2009

Format

The Competition is open to two (2) male and/or female teams in each event from each League or Association affiliated to Table Tennis Scotland. A team may be made up of:

Males: a pool of not more than four (4) players for any one team may be registered for the Competition but only three (3) of the (4) registered may play in any one match. The (3) players must be nominated at the start of each match.

Females: A pool of not more than three (3) for any one team may be registered for the Competition with the third player eligible to play in the doubles. The players for the singles games must be nominated before each match.

Order of Play: Team Captains have the option to play the players in their teams in any order they wish.

“Home” and “Away”: The Referee will decide “Home” and “Away” during the draw and scheduling for the Competition.

Injury: Once players have been nominated changes to replace players injured during the course of the match may not be made. The games of the injured player will be forfeited to the opposing team.

Results: If teams finish equal in points the result shall be determined by the I.T.T.F. formula of the ratio of games won and lost.

The format of play will be the current Swaythling & Corbillon Cup system:

MATCHES ARE PLAYED TO A RESULT ONLY

A Match will be over when either team has won 3 games.
