Information and Entry Form

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS (to be retained)

1. Matches will be the best of 3 games to 15 points using sandpaper bats. Final knockout rounds may be the best of 5 games.
2. Any games in which the score goes to 14 all will have a sudden death point to decide the game.
3. A double point ball can be played once during each match by each player. Each player can choose to play their double point ball at any time on their service when their score is 12 points or less.
4. The main colour of clothing must not be white or orange.
5. Non Scottish players who are not permanently resident in Scotland are eligible to play. However, they will not be eligible for the main knockout stage, only the plate event.
6. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
7. All competitors will be required to umpire.
8. All competitors must report to the top table on arrival.
9. The referee's decision shall be final on a point of law and on any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof.
10. The event will be seeded based on previous Scottish Ping Pong events and TTS ratings, with adjustments made based on opinion of tournament committee.
11. When dealing with unrated players, we will try to balance groups based on a prediction of their standards.
12. Players from the same club will be separated in groups where possible.
13. Photographs and videos taken on the day may be used for publicity purposes, unless otherwise indicated to the Organisers, in writing, on or before the day of competition.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. COVID-19 restrictions may be in place. Details will be e-mailed to all participants and posted online by 12th December.
2. The draw will take place on the 13th December and be posted online shortly after. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, this will be on the basis of last received first out.
3. The competition format is subject to change depending on the number of entries.
4. Payment should be completed with the entry. Those paying on the day will be subject to a £3 surcharge.
5. Play will be on Butterfly Europa tables. DHS D40+ 3 Star plastic balls will be used. Scoring machines will be used for all matches.
6. Unfortunately, there is no free parking at Ward Road Gym. The nearest pay-and-display car park is Bell Street Car Park.
7. No refunds of entry fees will be made after the date of the draw.
8. Doors will be open from 9am for practice before the event.
